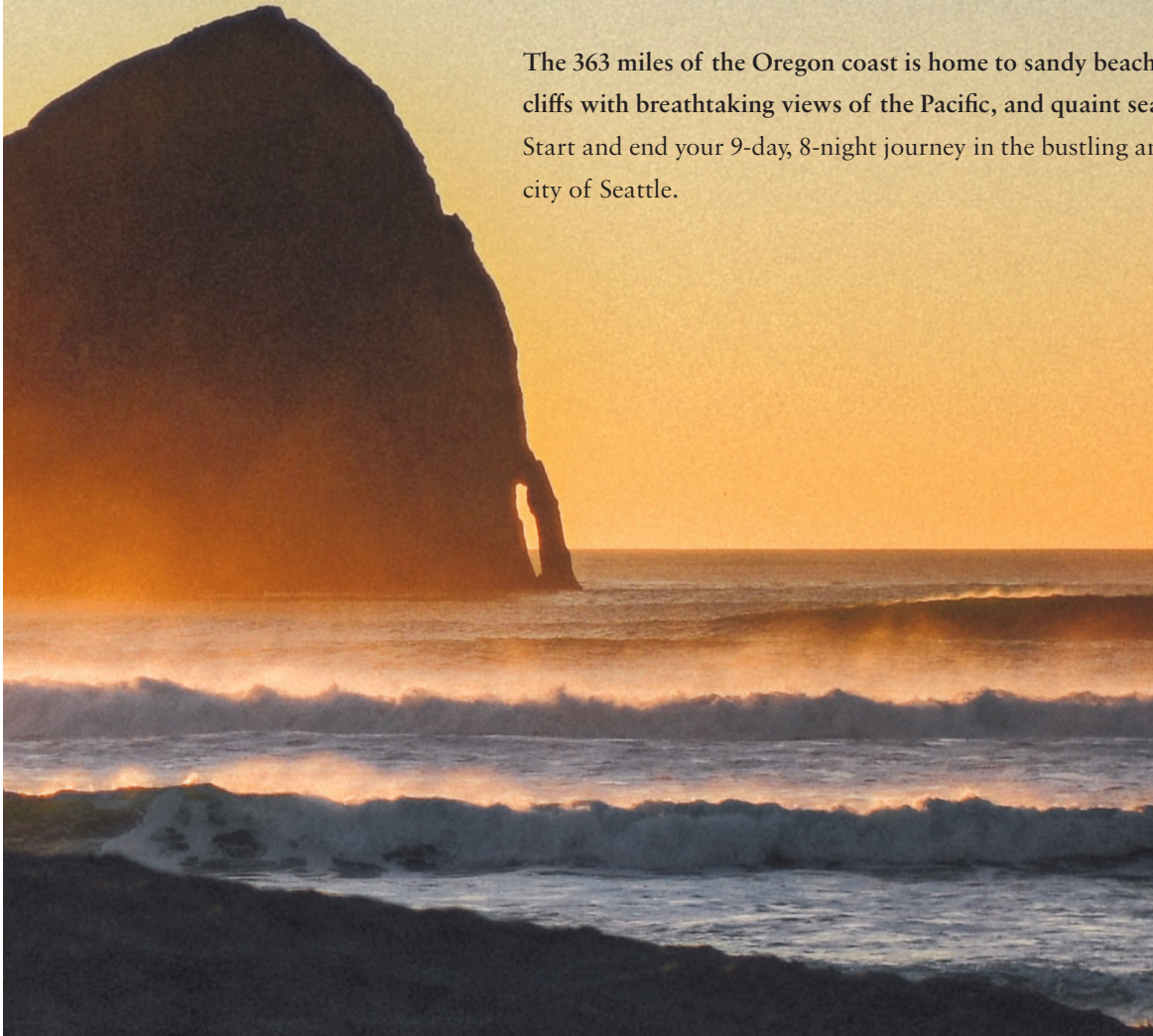


AMERICAN ROAD TRIP ADVENTURE

ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1

Pick up your RV in Seattle. After your orientation, head towards Olympia. Situated at the base of the Olympic Peninsula, this area boasts the quintessential craggy coasts and lush forests the Pacific northwest is known for. Overnight in Olympia in a camping accommodation.



Day 2

Enjoy breakfast in your RV before driving to Seaside. One of the most popular destinations on the Oregon Coast, Seaside is an adorable beach town. You can enjoy some of its most popular attractions, like the Ocean Promenade and the Seaside Aquarium, or get out and explore the natural wonders on a gorgeous hike. Overnight in Seaside in a camping accommodation.



Day 3

Explore the Northern Coast! Explore popular destinations like Cannon Beach, Oswald West State Park or Hug Point State Park to take in the stunning natural landscapes Oregon is known for. Overnight in Seaside in a camping accommodation.

Day 4

Make your way down the coast to Newport. Nestled between the Coastal Mountains, Pacific Ocean, and Yaquina Bay, Newport offers an authentic PNW coastal experience. Officially deemed the “Dungeness Crab Capital of the World”, its seafood is not to be missed. Overnight in Newport in a camping accommodation.

Day 5

Explore Newport! Visit Newport’s most popular attractions, the Oregon Coast Aquarium, the Hatfield Marine Science Center, and the Yaquina Bay Lighthouse and Natural Area. You’re in the whale watching capital of Oregon, so keep your eyes off the coast whenever you can! Overnight in Newport in a camping accommodation.



Day 6

Head inland towards McMinnville. This interior route will take you through the rolling hills and sprawling vineyards at the heart of Oregon's wine country. McMinnville is world famous for both its viticulture and artisan dining experience. It's also a great family-friendly getaway. Overnight in neighboring Carlton in a camping accommodation.

Day 7

Explore McMinnville and the Willamette Valley. Today is a great day to go wine tasting and sample Willamette Valley's famous pinot noir, or to wander the downtown streets of McMinnville. Take in the breathtaking views around McMinnville or check out some local hikes. Overnight in Carlton in a camping accommodation.

Day 8

Drive to north to Silver Creek, WA. A sleepy PNW town filled with verdant forests perfect for hiking, fishing, and canoeing, this is the perfect way to begin to wind down your trip. Overnight in Silver Creek in a camping accommodation.

Day 9

Pack up camp for the final time and begin the drive to Seattle where you will drop off your RV.
