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Day 1

Morro Bay is also a perfect spot to relax on the beach or rent some gear to get out and catch some waves. Overnight in Morro Bay in a beachside camping accommodation.

Enjoy breakfast in Morro Bay before driving to the charming coastal city of Santa Barbara. Along the way, pass through Pismo Beach which is famous for its sand dunes. Overnight in Santa Barbara in a beachside camping accommodation.

Day 7

Explore Santa Barbara! Relax on the beach or catch some waves and wander the charming downtown with its many upscale shops, restaurants, and tasting rooms. You'll quickly see why this town is called "the American Riviera". Overnight in Santa Barbara in a beachside camping accommodation.
