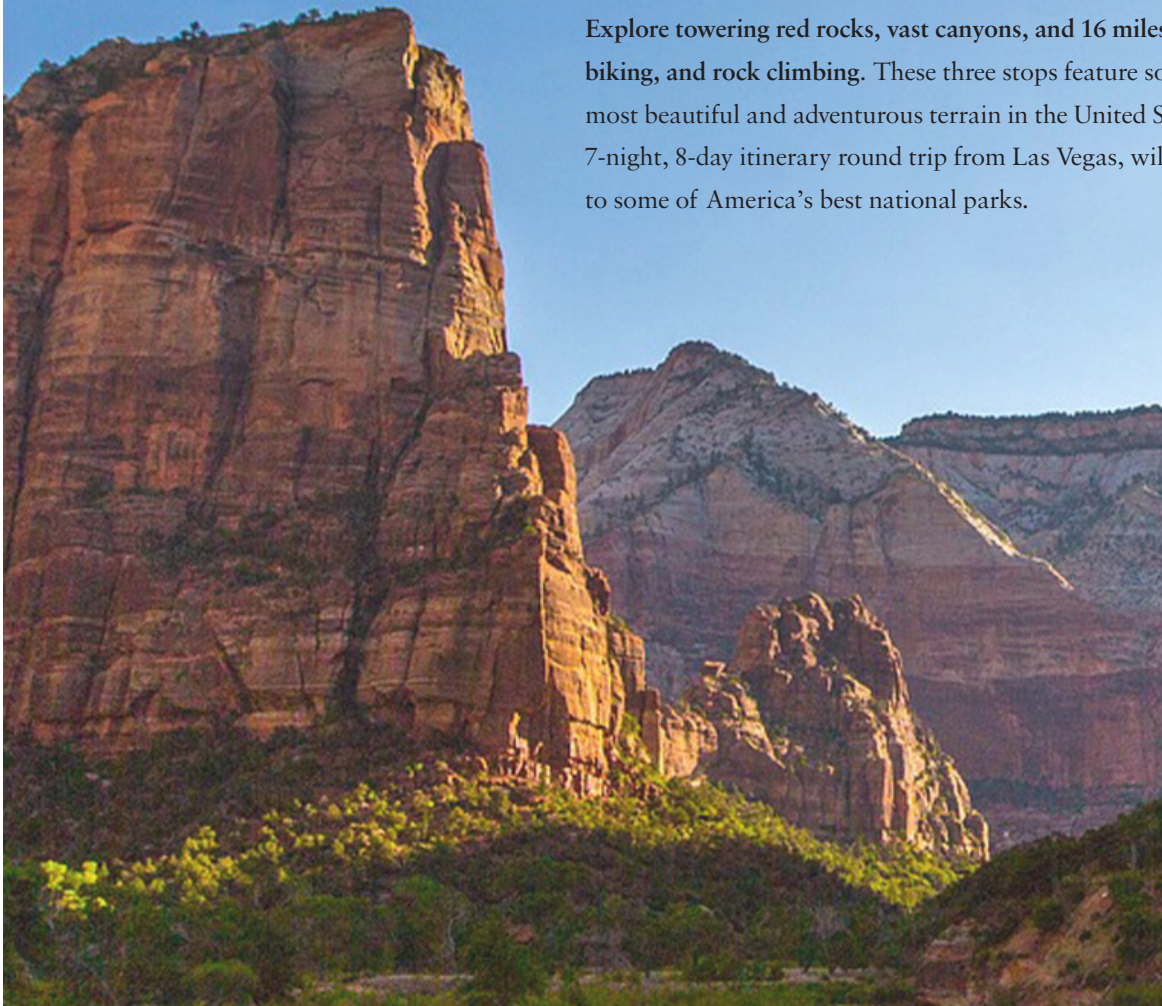


AMERICAN ROAD TRIP ADVENTURE

Bryce, Grand Canyon AND Zion

Explore towering red rocks, vast canyons, and 16 miles of hiking, biking, and rock climbing. These three stops feature some of the most beautiful and adventurous terrain in the United States. This 7-night, 8-day itinerary round trip from Las Vegas, will take you to some of America's best national parks.

ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1

Pick up your RV in the Las Vegas area. After your orientation, drive to Zion National Park. Overnight in Zion National Park in a camping accommodation.

Day 2

Enjoy your first full day by exploring the natural beauty of Zion National Park! Enjoy a hike through the Narrows, the Canyon Overlook Trail, or Watchman Trail. If hiking is not your thing but you still want to see this beautiful national park, take a drive along the Zion Canyon Scenic Drive. Overnight in Zion National Park in a camping accommodation.

Day 3

After breakfast, head north towards Bryce Canyon National Park. Bryce Canyon is filled with hoodoos (irregularly eroded spires) and ample viewpoints for some of the best views in Utah. Overnight in Bryce Canyon National Park in a camping accommodation.

Day 4

Explore Bryce Canyon National Park, one of the most beautiful places in southern Utah! Head to Inspiration Point for a great viewpoint of the main amphitheater or take a trip to Fairlyland Canyon, Sunrise Point, and Bryce Point for incredible views of the park. Overnight in Bryce Canyon National Park in a camping accommodation.

Day 5

Drive south from Bryce Canyon National Park to the North Rim of Grand Canyon National Park. The Grand Canyon is one of the largest and popular attractions in the world. With equally as many lookout points and amazing views as the South Rim, the North Rim sees only a fraction of the visitors. Overnight in Grand Canyon National Park - North Rim in a camping accommodation.



Day 6

Explore the North Rim of the Grand Canyon! Take in the views of the unbelievable Grand Canyon with many viewpoints and hikes. Visit Bright Angel Point, Angels Window, and Cape Royal, and grab a drink at sunset at the North Rim Lodge. Overnight in Grand Canyon National Park - North Rim in a camping accommodation.

Day 7

Head south east towards Snow Canyon State Park. In any other state, Snow Canyon would probably be considered a national park. Snow Canyon features 16 miles of hiking and biking trails, technical rock climbing, and a stunning red rock landscape. This park is a wonderful place to spend your last day. Overnight in Snow Canyon State Park in a camping accommodation.

Day 8

Pack up camp for the final time and begin the drive to Las Vegas where you will drop off your RV.
