ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1

Pick up your RV in the Denver area. After your orientation, drive to Trinidad, where you will stay the night at Trinidad Lake State Park at a campground in your RV.



Day 2

Pack up camp and head towards Santa Fe, New Mexico, where you will spend the next three nights. Overnight in Santa Fe.



Day 3

Enjoy your first full day in Santa Fe! With gorgeous Pueblo-style architecture everywhere you look, a thriving art and culture scene, and award-winning cuisine, Santa Fe is the ultimate Southwest destination. Wander through the galleries and museums, attend one of the many festivals in the Plaza, and hike in the nearby Sangre de Cristo Mountains. Overnight in Santa Fe.

Day 4

Continue exploring Santa Fe or consider taking a trip to Bandelier National Monument and step back in time as you make your way through the preserved homes of the Ancestral Pueblo people who called this area home between 1150 and 1600 AD. Overnight in Santa Fe.

Day 5

Depart Santa Fe and head to the Great Sand Dunes National Park in Southern Colorado. Overnight in Great Sand Dunes National Park.

Day 6

Explore Great Sand Dunes National Park! Grab your sandboard or sand sled (don't worry, you can rent one near the park) and get ready for some adventure! Overnight in Great Sand Dunes National Park.



Day 7

Pack up camp and head towards Buena Vista, Colorado. With beautiful views and great outdoor adventures like horseback riding, hot springs soaking, and abundant hiking, your time in Buena Vista will be memorable. Overnight in Buena Vista.

Day 8

Pack up camp form the last time and begin the drive to Denver where you will drop off your RV.
