# Arches, Canyonlands AND Central Colorado

On this 10-night, 11-day road trip, visit several of the western United States' most lauded national parks, including Arches, Canyonlands, and Mesa Verde. Soak in hot springs, marvel at natural sandstone arches, learn about the Ancestral Pueblo people who lived within storied cliff dwellings, and go whitewater rafting along a famed stretch of whitewater on the Arkansas River.

## ITINERARY OVERVIEW

### Day 1

Pick up your RV in the Denver area. After your orientation, drive west towards Glenwood Springs, where you will stay the night at a campground in your RV.



### Day 2

Explore Glenwood Springs and soak in the famous mineral hot springs, hike one of the many trails in the area, or simply enjoy your time on the river. Overnight in Glenwood Springs.

### Day 3

Depart Glenwood Springs and continue west towards Moab, Utah. Set up camp and stay overnight in Moab.


### Day 4

Enjoy your first day in Moab by exploring Arches National Park, the world's largest concentration of natural sandstone arches. Hike to some of the most iconic spots in the park, including Delicate Arch or Landscape Arch. Overnight in Moab.



### Day 5

Today is a great day to explore Canyonlands National Park. Canyonlands National Park was carved out of the earth by wind and water into some of the most pristine red rock cliffs and canyons the world has to offer. Inhabited by various tribes of people for over 10,000 years, Canyonlands is full of petroglyphs from different periods in time. The scenic drives here are highly sought after, each making for a perfect day-long adventure with tons of viewpoint and short hikes. Overnight in Moab.



## Day 6

Pack up camp and head towards Mesa Verde National Park in Colorado. Mesa Verde dates back to A.D. 550 and is known for the cliff dwellings of the Ancestral Pueblo people who inhabited this area over 700 years ago. Learn about the cultures that once called this place home, and gaze in wonder at the houses and rooms built into the cliffside. Overnight near Mesa Verde National Park.

## Day 7

Continue your adventure towards the town of Durango, Colorado, where you will spend the next two evenings. Overnight in Durango.

## Day 8

Enjoy a full day in Durango. With a variety of outdoor activities, Durango is a hub for world-class mountain biking and hiking. For a more leisurely activity, climb aboard the historic Durango and Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad to travel through the canyons of Southwest Colorado. Overnight in Durango.

## Day 9

Pack up camp and head northwest towards Buena Vista, Colorado. Overnight in Buena Vista.

## Day 10

Explore Buena Vista! With beautiful views and great outdoor adventures like horseback riding, hot springs soaking, and abundant hiking, your time in Buena Vista will be memorable. You'll definitely want to go whitewater rafting, as the Arkansas River is one of the most popular destinations in the world to brave the rapids, and the Buena Vista Whitewater Park in town makes it easy for all levels to give it a try.

## Day 11

Pack up camp for the last time and begin the drive to Denver where you will drop off your RV.
